



Purchasing and Bid Laws

The District is required to watch categorical spending and adhere to the State Purchasing and Bid Laws. We **recommend** purchasing from the links below on all purchases. Due to the district spending over \$75,000 on computer equipment, fuel, and potentially on furniture, we are **required** to comply with the bid laws by purchasing equipment from the links provided below.

Bottom Line: By purchasing from Washington State Department of Enterprise Services, KCDA, National IPA/TCPN, OETC, Washington Learning Resource (WLS), U.S. Communities, Sourcewell, ESD 112, or Piggybacking the Spokane School's bids, the District will stay in compliance with the state bid laws.
